We are aware that there has been some confusion regarding the enrolment process for **current WHSC Year 6 students** who will transition into Year 7 next year.

While students already enrolled at Whites Hill State College do not need to "reapply" for a place, we are still asking all Year 6 families to book an enrolment interview time.

These meetings are an important part of our transition process and provide an opportunity for families, students and staff to engage in a reconnection conversation as we begin mapping out each student's transition into secondary schooling. The interview process helps us better understand student aspirations, interests, support needs and pathways so that we can build a successful and personalised transition into Year 7.

As a Prep to Year 12 college, one of our strengths is the ability to carefully support students through this important milestone, and these conversations form an important part of that journey.
