



Senior Agreement

Congratulations on completing your Senior Education and Training Plan (Set Plan). We are excited to share your educational journey over the next two years. Whites Hill State College is committed to providing a breadth of opportunities and programs for senior school students to realise their full potential as creative and intelligent young adults.

Year 11 & 12 students are considered post compulsory students, that is, they have made a conscious decision to return to Whites Hill State College to **successfully** complete their senior studies. Successful completion of senior refers to:

- Achieving a QCE or QCIA
- Achieving academic success in all subjects / courses undertaken
- Completion of all drafts and final submissions of work
- Satisfactory completion of VET competencies

Students must meet the conditions of the senior agreement to be considered for any of the following senior privileges:

- Rewards excursions / activities
- Senior leadership positions
- Senior badge
- Senior jersey
- Attendance at the formal
- Extracurricular activities including sporting team activities, camps

CRITERIA FOR SENIOR AGREEMENT

- ✓ **Demonstrate WHSC CARES Values**
- ✓ Regular attendance to all classes; at least 95% attendance overall as per **Standards for Success**
- ✓ All absences and late arrivals must be explained as per **Standards for Success**
- ✓ Correctly wear the school uniform as per WHSC dress code
- ✓ Attend all sporting carnivals throughout the year
- ✓ High standard of behaviour in and out of class time in accordance with WHSC Student Code of Conduct
- ✓ Compliance with the College assessment policy including applications for extensions and submission of assessment
- ✓ Students undertaking external courses or SBT's **MUST** give priority to school assessment & exams, submit assessment on the due date & catch up on all classwork missed.
- ✓ Minimum of satisfactory behaviour and effort (A/B/C) on report cards
- ✓ No outstanding breaches – e.g. refusal to follow teachers instructions, attend reflections as per **Standards for success**
- ✓ Paid resources hire fees or payment plan in place, as per **Standards for Success**

- Be a positive role model for students across the College
- Actively participate in own learning
- Actively participate in school events

- ✓ I understand that my preferred subject choices may not be offered due to class size.
- ✓ I understand that the standard Student Resource Scheme fee is \$345 (subject to change), and that some VET courses come with an additional financial levy.
- ✓ I recognise the importance of meeting 'pre-requisite' in subjects. I understand that if I have not met pre-requisite results by the end of Year 10, I will be advised to change out of this subject selection to ensure that I can successfully complete my senior schooling and achieve my Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) – see Senior Subjects Handbook 2024 pg 10. NB: In General and Applied subjects, Students accrue QCE points for each unit they pass towards their QCE – therefore if a student fails even one unit, their QCE may be jeopardised.
