Bilinguals are also consistently better able to deal with distractions. They have enhanced attentional control abilities and are better able to concentrate.

### 2. Academic Excellence

Research at Cambridge University shows that bilinguals successfully transfer these enhanced cognitive skills into greater academic achievements than their monolingual peers, especially in maths, reading, and vocabulary.

### 3. Global Connections and Perspectives

Being able to speak proficiently in two or more languages has always been hugely beneficial across different professions. The ability to adapt to and absorb different cultures is in itself a precious commodity to companies operating across multiple countries. French is 5th most spoken language in the world, and is widespread across the globe.

### 4. Cultural Benefits

The exposure to two languages assists students in developing an appreciation for differences in cultures. Not only can bilinguals successfully interact with a wider variety of people, but they are more open-minded towards and appreciative of other cultures.

For those families with a French background, learning the language leads to preservation of culture and the ability to converse with extended family members who may not speak English.

### 5. It's Fun and Entertaining

It is fun learning multiple languages at the same time. Students get engaged in different cultures and customs. The ability to speak multiple languages allows us to communicate with many people and make friends.
