## Standards for Success

**Resource Ready – students need to ensure that they have the resources required to be successful at school. There are two main options:**

- a. Students are up to date with SRS and have purchased the relevant booklist through the uniform shop, or
- b. Students have independently provided all the resources covered by the SRS and purchased the relevant booklist through a third party provider.

**The College has 90% expectation across the following CARES categories:**

- a. 90% Attendance (including arriving on time) or 90% Attendance including medical certificates. Otherwise an individual exemption needs to be applied for and granted by the Head of School.
- b. 90% Uniform compliance. Individual exemptions need to be applied for and granted by Head of School. This includes hair and jewellery.
- c. 90% Ready To Learn (RTL) compliance:
  - i. Being prepared for class with all of their required learning equipment, including a charged device in secondary (if applicable).
    - Students who honestly forget equipment can collect book/pen from the office prior to school.
    - Students can charge their devices in their own time (a charging station is available in the ILC)
  - ii. Completion of their set homework.
  - iii. Bringing and utilising their College diary.
  - iv. IT compliance (including the appropriate use of both mobile phones and other electronic devices.)
  - v. Participation in all of their required coursework.
  - vi. Remaining in the designated learning area under the direction of the teacher.

**Students demonstrate a high level adherence with the College's Responsible Behaviour Plan for Students (RBPS), including:**

- a. Not having any outstanding detentions (lunchtime or afterschool).
- b. Not having a major breach of the RBPS that resulted in a long term suspension (over 11 days).
- c. Not having more than two major breaches of the RBPS that resulted in short term suspensions (10 days or less)
