Prep-Year 12

- The college CARES values.

Prep-Year 6

- Having no more than five major behaviour incidents as outlined in the [Student Code of Conduct](#) in the previous 20 weeks that have resulted in an 'admin follow-up'.
- Having no outstanding Success Room reflections

Years 7-12

- Having no short or long-term suspensions within the previous 20 school weeks.
- Having no more than five major behaviour incidents as outlined in the [Student Code of Conduct](#) in the previous 20 weeks.
