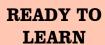
## **Teacher Actions**

- CARES reminder and/or redirection is given.

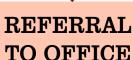
- Teacher records behaviour as a MINOR on OneSchool.
- Classroom teacher issues consequence to student.
- Classroom teacher records behaviour, consequence and parent contact on OneSchool.
- MAJOR: Consistent frequent MINOR referrals egual MAJOR.
- Teacher records behaviour as a MAJOR on OneSchool and refers student to HOS.
- HOS issues consequence and action is taken.
- HOS records consequence, action, parent contact on OneSchool.



BUDDY **CLASS** OR AND CONSEQUENCE



- · Student accepts consequence if learning of others is disrupted, student goes to buddy class for 10 minutes.
- Re-connect conversation with teacher and consequence is accepted.
- · Student now follows CARES expectations.











### Immediate Office referrals can be given for major behaviour incidents

- Refusal to go to buddy class.
- Physical Misconduct.
- IT/Phone Misconduct.
- Illicit substances misconduct.
- Misconduct involving object/s or property.
- Threats to others.
- Verbal misconduct directed towards an individual including bullying/harassment.
- Possession of prohibited item/s.
- Misconduct that brings the school into disrepute.
- Conduct prejudicial to the good order and management of the school.
